

Instructions For Preparing Final Papers To ASCC2002

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Abstract

This is where the abstract should be placed. It should consist of one paragraph which provides a concise summary of the material discussed in the article below. It is preferable not to use footnotes in the abstract or the title. The acknowledgment for funding organizations etc. is placed in a separate section at the end of the text. We wish you success with the preparation of your manuscript.

1 Introduction

The Proceedings CD-ROM produced for the Asian Control Conference 2002 will contain all the papers accepted for the conference which have been received by the publishing house no later than **May 31st 2002**. Papers received after that date will not be included. Papers which appear on the CD-ROM have undergone the review process of the International Programme Committee of ASCC'02. Comments of reviewers are sent to the authors. Authors are asked to prepare and submit electronic versions of their manuscripts according to the instructions below.

2 Manuscript Preparation

The papers must be typed in English using MS Word, or LaTeX or any other word processor that is able to generate PDF files or Postscript files. This instruction page is an example of the format and font sizes to be used. MS Word users can download from the conference site these instructions in Word format *Manuscript_Word_Sample.doc* and change it accordingly while preserving the format. LaTeX users may download the *Manuscript_Latex_Sample.tex* and *ASCCart.sty* files. The first file, *Manuscript_Latex_Sample.tex*, can be used as an example and should include the package *ASCCart.sty* that contains most of the format instructions.

It follows detailed instructions valid for any word processor. The title of the paper is typed in boldface 18pt and centered on the page. The author's name is typed in capital and lower case bold letters and centered on the page. Directly under the author's name in capital and lower case letters and also centered is the author's affiliation, address, plus e-mail address of (at least) the corresponding author. Manuscripts must be typed single spaced using 10 point characters. Only times, times roman, times new roman and symbol fonts are accepted. The text must fall within a frame of 174 mm x 245 mm centered on an A4 page (210 mm x 297 mm). The Oddside margin is 18 mm, Top margin 28 mm, Bottom margin 24 mm. Paragraphs are separated by 6 points and with no indentation. The text of each paper is written in two columns and justified. Each column has a width of 83 mm and the columns are separated by a margin of 8 mm. The maximum length of the manuscript is 6 pages. Do not number the pages. The final format in which the papers will appear on the Proceedings CD-ROM will be a PDF file. Authors are requested to send a PDF file of their final paper to be included directly in the CD-ROM.

2.1 Figures and tables

Figures and tables should be centered in the column, numbered consecutively throughout the text, and each should have a caption underneath it (see for example Table 1). Care should be taken that the lettering is not too small. Lettering in the figures should not be smaller than the size of the typed letters in the text. All figures and tables should be included in the electronic versions of the manuscript. DO NOT use colored photographs and figures.

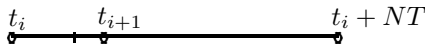


Figure 1: This is an example of a figure caption.

2.2 Equations

Equations should be typed within the text, centered, and should be numbered consecutively throughout the text. They should be referred to in the text as Equation (n). Their numbers should be typed in parentheses, flush right, as in the following example.

$$PA + A^T P - PBR^{-1}B^T P + Q = 0. \quad (1)$$

3 Generating a PDF File

The PDF format will be the final format under which the papers will appear on the Proceedings CD-ROM. Therefore you are strongly advised to submit your paper as PDF documents. If this is not possible, Postscript format is also accepted as long as no fonts other than the recommended fonts are used.

In any case you are advised to use the packages GhostScript and GhostView which are capable of viewing both Postscript and PDF files and converting between the two. These packages are free and can be downloaded from <http://www.cs.wisc.edu/~ghost/>.

3.1 LaTeX users on any platform

The command *pdflatex* (which is available in some LaTeX systems, for example MikTeX 1.20e) compiles a TeX file directly into a PDF document. If you use it, then you may go to the submission instructions on the next section.

If you use the traditional LaTeX compiler to produce a DVI document, then the *dvips* command will transform it into Postscript file. You may use next the *ps2pdf* command which is available in the GhostScript package to obtain the required PDF document.

3.2 Users of MS Word and other word processors

- (i) Within your word processor package, select a standard postscript printer driver such as Apple Laserwriter or HP LaserJet postscript driver. (You might need to “install” one of these printer drivers.)
- (ii) Configure the driver to write the postscript to a file instead of the printer.
- (iii) Configure the driver to download all fonts (this may be automatic), and if available configure the driver for MAXIMUM POSTSCRIPT PORTABILITY. Do not use internal printer fonts.

- (iv) Ensure that the pages print in correct order (NOT reverse order).
- (v) “Print” to the file giving it an extension “.ps” if requested.

At this stage you should have a Postscript document. To convert into PDF proceed as follows.

- (i) Open your Postscript document in GhostView.

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ASCC1234.pdf. (In case of a Postscript format, the
“.ps” extension should be used instead.)

5 Conclusion

All the manuscripts must be received by the publish-
ing house no later than May 31st, 2002, in order to
be included in the conference CD-ROM and the final
program.

In addition authors should post or fax to the conference
secretariat a signed transfer of copyright form.

Acknowledgments

The acknowledgment for funding organizations etc.
should be placed in a separate section at the end of
the text.
