Soon Hock sits on the Board of Directors of several government agencies, public listed companies and civic organizations. He is Chairman of the National Family Council and Centre for Fathering; Honorary Advisor to the Singapore Heart Foundation and Council Member of the Singapore Eye Foundation.

He is presently the Founder and Managing Director of PLAN-B ICAG Pte Ltd, a boutique corporate advisory firm. Soon Hock holds an honours degree in Electrical Engineering from the University of Singapore and is a Fellow of the Institute of Engineers (Singapore), the Institution of Engineering and Technology (UK) and the Singapore Institute of Directors.
