POSTER PRESENTATION JUDGING CRITERIAS

First Impression	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• How difficult is it to read the poster?• How crowded is the poster?• Does the poster stimulate interest and discussion?• The poster is creatively designed and the style is attractive.
Poster Layout	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Is the poster visually jumbled?• How easy is it to follow the sequence in the poster?
Organization and Readability	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Is font size or style easily readable?• How much text does the poster contain?• Are the objectives clearly stated?• Was the content suitable for experts and non-experts alike?
Methods and Results	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• How detailed, appropriate, original are the methods and is there enough explanation?• How clear and well labelled are graphs and figures?• How well are the results presented?
Solutions and Conclusions	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The analysis and solution of the presented problem offer no ambiguity.• Are any conclusions presented and if so do they reflect the aims and are they supported by the data?• Is there a memorable “take-home” message?
Significance of Ideas and Scientific Content	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Relevance and impact of the proposed idea to the current research arena.• There is sufficient scientific explanation.
Knowledge of Subject	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• How much do the student’s explanations demonstrate knowledge/ownership for his/her work?• How much is the student confident and enthusiastic to explain his/her work?
